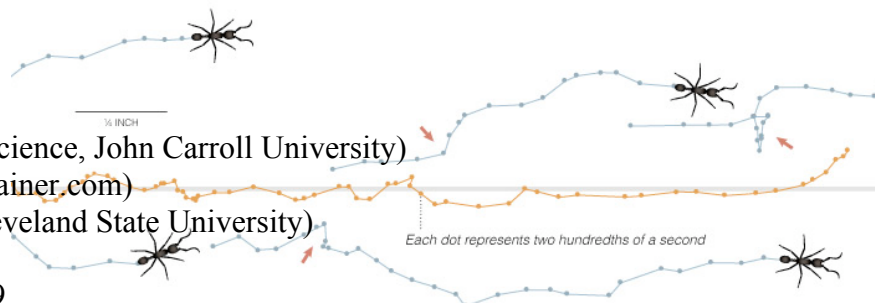

What: For most people, the word “swarm” conjures a mental image of millions of insects moving en masse from one place to another. Although some insects do swarm, they aren’t the only things that do. In fact, many important human activities – such as air travel and sending packages – can be modeled using swarms and the properties that emerge from the individual actions of swarm members. The challenge is figuring out exactly how such emergent properties arise, and how they can be integrated into programs to make the activities of humans (and robots) more efficient. Come to discuss swarms and swarming behavior from mathematical, biological and applied perspectives, and to think about how swarm behavior can be used to help us better meet the challenges of everyday life! The diverse backgrounds of our experts should make for an engaging and interesting discussion.
