2. A *curriculum vitae*.
3. A brief letter from the applicant's department chair indicating his/her support. If the applicant chooses to use the funds towards the cost of a course release during the fall of 2006, the chair's letter also should indicate that s/he approves of using the funds in this way. *A Baker-Nord Seminar Scholarship in no way obligates the recipient's department or school to allow for a teaching load reduction.*
