CONFERENCE SITE

The ICEI 2010 will be held at the Hobart and William Smith (HWS) Colleges. A map of the HWS campus may be found at http://www.hws.edu/about/campus_maps.aspx
HWS Colleges are conveniently located between Rochester, Syracuse and Ithaca, New York, at the top end of Seneca Lake (see maps). This is one of the well known Finger Lakes, regarded as New York's premier outdoor recreation paradise. Although centrally located, Geneva is fairly isolated providing an ideal atmosphere for close interactions between speakers, faculty, and students. The conference hall at HWS is located directly above the communal dining area, where all meals will be served.
