



# Mann Child Policy Externships

## *Mann Child Policy Externships:*

- Provide the opportunity for undergraduates to work directly with professionals who design and implement policies that impact the lives of children and families.
- Place students with local policy organizations working in areas of child health, education, law, juvenile justice, mental health, and child welfare.
- Provide 3-6 hours of course credit.
- Fulfill the *SAGES Capstone* experience in some departments.
- Require a commitment of at least 10 hours per week.
- May provide a stipend for overtime work, pending the availability of funding.
- Are available fall, spring, and summer semesters.

## *Selection Criteria:*

- Junior or senior status preferred, but qualified sophomores will be considered.
- Completion of at least two social science classes, preferably with a child or family focus.
- 3.2 overall GPA with a 3.4 GPA in major.
- Students who have completed or are enrolled in CHST 301 will be given first priority.

## *To apply for a Mann Child Policy Externship, submit:*

- A completed application and a 2-3 page essay (see <http://www.case.edu/arstci/childstudies>).
- A current resume.
- One letter of recommendation from a professor.

### *Application deadlines:*

*October 15<sup>th</sup> for a spring externship*

*March 15<sup>th</sup> for a summer or fall externship*
