The Department of Modern Languages and Literatures announces an opening for a tenure-track appointment in Spanish beginning with the 2009-10 academic year. Rank is open, but appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor is preferred. A senior rank appointment will require evidence of excellent research and recognition of the research program at a national level, as well as other qualifications necessary for tenure and promotion at our institution as stated in the Faculty Handbook and in the standards of the Department of Modern Languages and Literatures. Dynamic teacher/scholar in Contemporary Latin American Studies. Preferred areas of specialization: Caribbean Literatures and Cultures and Andean Studies. Secondary interests in one or more of the following areas are highly desirable: Afro-Caribbean literature, culture and film; cultural studies; visual studies. Native or near-native fluency in Spanish. Ph.D. in hand by time of appointment. Ability to teach language courses at all levels, interest/experience in multi-media pedagogy, and a strong commitment to teaching excellence and interdisciplinary learning. Willingness to teach occasional course in Ethnic Studies Program and/or World Literature Program and develop new courses also desirable. Normal teaching load is 3/2.
