

Case Western Reserve University --- Department of Mathematics

In anticipation the reorganization of its new Department of Mathematics, Applied Mathematics and Statistics, Case Western Reserve University is searching for at least one tenure track faculty (rank open, junior preferred) in Statistics. This hire is part of an effort to build a statistics group which interfaces well with the existing expertise in applied and computational mathematics and can interact with faculty in other departments, for example physics, astronomy and engineering. Preference will be given to candidates with expertise in spatial statistics, statistical learning, computational statistics and Bayesian statistics. All candidates should hold a Ph.D. in Statistics or a related field by the time of appointment, have demonstrated teaching/mentoring experience, and a publication record appropriate to rank. Demonstrated excellence in teaching and mentoring, and a record showing the ability to formulate and sustain a line of research which has been recognized for quality and depth is required for consideration at the rank of associate professor. A strong record in mentoring and leadership, with evidence that the candidate is a well-established, well-recognized statistician is required for consideration at the rank of professor. The normal teaching load is two courses per semester. Candidates should submit a letter of application, curriculum vitae, a statement of teaching philosophy and experience, evidence of teaching excellence, and a statement of current and future research plans. In addition, they should arrange for three letters of recommendation to be submitted directly by writers.
