

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY, CASE WESTERN RESERVE UNIVERSITY invites applications for an endowed faculty position at the rank of Instructor or Senior Instructor. Candidates must be committed to excellence in undergraduate teaching, mentoring, and service. The successful candidate will be appointed as the John Teagle Professorial Fellow in Chemistry. A PhD in chemistry and experience teaching freshman and sophomore-level undergraduate chemistry courses with demonstrated excellence in teaching are required; postdoctoral research experience is preferred. Candidates for Senior Instructor should also have experience advising and mentoring students, leading undergraduate course and curriculum development, and implementing innovative teaching methods and technologies. Normal teaching loads for Instructors are two introductory courses per semester, including general and organic chemistry lecture and laboratory courses, which may have multiple sections. The position is available for the 2013–2014 academic year or until filled.
