

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY, CASE WESTERN RESERVE UNIVERSITY invites applications for a tenure-track assistant professor position. Preferred candidates will have plans for research involving synthetic organic chemistry as applied to (1) Chemical Biology and/or (2) Energy & Materials, as broadly defined, two areas that overlap current research thrusts in the Department and across campus. Candidates must be committed to excellence in interdisciplinary research, teaching, and mentoring at both undergraduate and graduate levels. A Ph.D., research publications, and postdoctoral experience are required. Normal teaching load for faculty with active research programs is one course per semester plus ancillary duties. A letter of application, CV, and summary of research plans should be sent by November 9, 2012.
