Instructor/Senior Instructor in Music (Historical Performance Practice)

The Case Western Reserve University Department of Music seeks a dynamic musician, dancer and teacher, to participate in our nationally recognized program in Historical Performance Practice. Applications are being accepted for Instructor or Senior Instructor for 2013-14. Candidates must have a completed doctorate and a successful record as a professional performer and teacher at both the undergraduate and graduate level. Candidates with exceptional qualifications and a strong national reputation may be considered for Senior Instructor.

The successful applicant will have responsibilities in the areas of creative activity and teaching. With a normal load of three courses per semester, duties include coaching the Case/CIM Baroque Orchestra, the Baroque Chamber Ensembles, and the Baroque Dance Ensemble, teaching a regular seminar in the performance practice of Baroque Dance, ongoing advising of students on historical string practice, and participation in administration of the Historical Performance Practice program, attending meetings, hearing auditions, lecture-recitals, etc.
