Candidates must demonstrate a successful record as a professional performer and university teacher. Graduate degree in music required. Candidates with exceptional qualifications and a strong national reputation may be considered for Senior Instructor.

The successful applicant will have responsibilities in the areas of teaching and service. With a normal load of three courses per semester, duties include teaching classes, seminars, and ensembles as needed, accompanying ensembles and individual students, administering accompaniment services, hearing auditions and juries.
