

English Major Requirements

Total Hours: 30 hours (minimum)

The major in English requires a minimum of 30 semester hours in English courses above the 100 level. At least 18 hours must be at the 300 level or above.

Completion of a major portfolio: *** <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One graded paper from ENGL 200 or 300 (files of such papers are kept in the department office) • One graded paper from ENGL 380 • An essay reflecting on one's experience in the major • The graded capstone paper from ENGL 395 	

** Double majors must take ENGL 380, though the capstone course may be taken, with permission of the Chair of English, in their other major area.

*** Majors doing a capstone in another department will supply a copy of their capstone project for the English Department's major portfolio requirement (see #6 above).
