**Quarterback:** Drop back, throwing release, and follow through  
**Running Back:** Ball handling, running, blocking, and receiving  
**Wide Receiver:** Release, route technique, and receiving  
**Tight End:** Blocking, route technique, and receiving  
**Offensive Line:** Run and Pass blocking techniques  
**Defensive Line:** Playing through blocks and pass rush techniques  
**Linebacker:** Run defense, pass drops, and blitz techniques  
**Defensive Back:** Pass drops and coverage techniques
