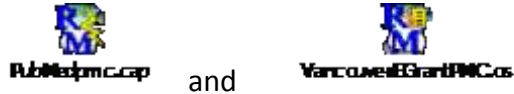


## Reference Manager, Government Grants & PMCID's

Along with this explanatory document, there are two files:



The .cap file should be pasted into the IMPORT folder of Reference Manager. Double click [here](#) , you will be prompted with a FILE DOWNLOAD window, SAVE into the IMPORT Folder of Reference Manager.

The .os file should be pasted into the STYLES folder of Reference Manager. Double click [here](#) , you will be prompted with a FILE DOWNLOAD window, SAVE into the STYLES Folder of Reference Manager.

Be sure to make the both the FREE FULL TEXT and the PMC articles ELECTRIC CITATION's in Reference Manager, the default is JOURNAL. You will need to include the URL in the WEB/URL slot of the citation record in Reference Manager. If you want to keep the PM # which defaults to WEB/URL, cut it and paste it into the RELATED LINKS slot. Be sure to complete the field for ACCESS DATE. In this field, the year must be FOUR digits.

If you are just pasting the PMCID into an existing citation record in a Reference Manager Database, insert it into the USER DEF 2 slot.

If you are importing totally new records from PubMed, use the PubMedpmc.cap for importing the citations and everything should go to the correct field.

The output style, VancouverEGrantPMC.os, will create bibliographies according to NIH specifications if you have followed these directions.
