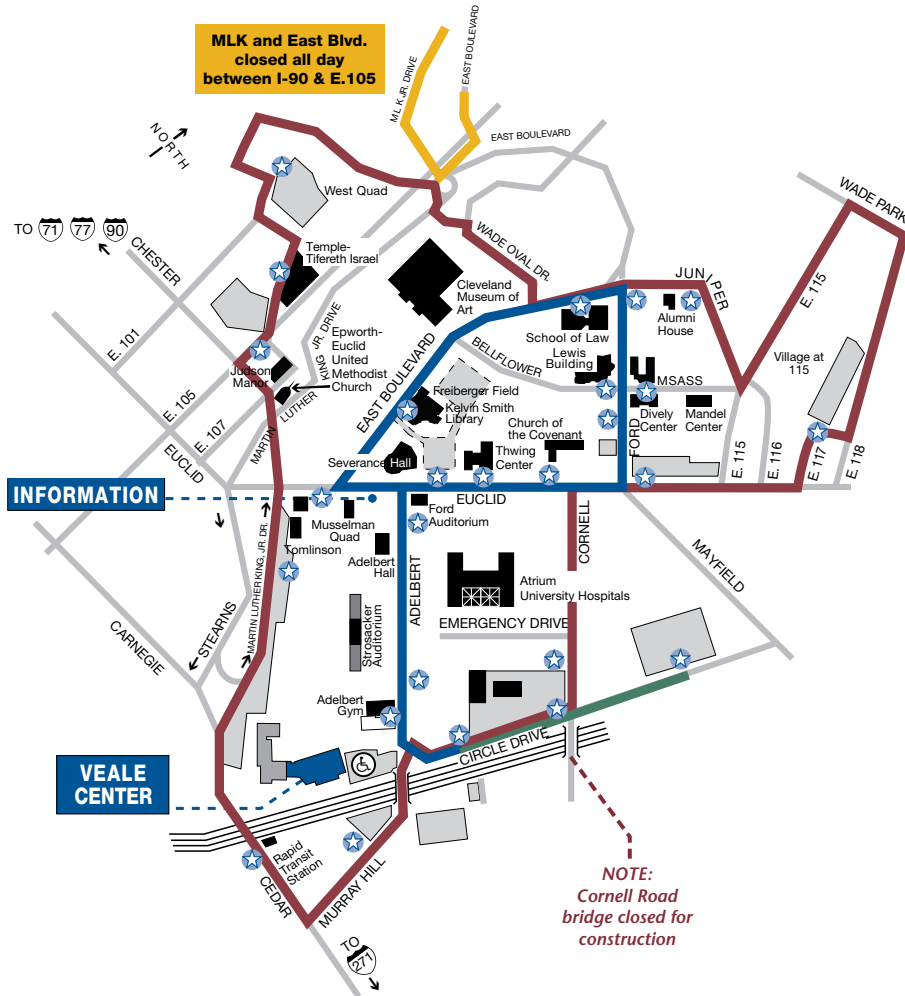


Case Western Reserve University Commencement Day 2009



TRAVEL ADVISORY FOR COMMENCEMENT DAY Cleveland Marathon

The Cleveland Marathon takes place on Commencement Day. The race route passes through University Circle on East Boulevard and Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive. Marathon participants are expected between 11:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. This will affect both parking and traffic routes on the morning of commencement:

- Martin Luther King, Jr. (MLK) Drive and East Boulevard will be totally closed to vehicular traffic between the I-90/Route 2 Shoreway and East 105 from 8:00 a.m. until about 4:30 p.m.

If you are driving to campus from the east or west on I-90 the morning of Commencement, look for an electronic signboard (one for each direction) telling you to exit at East 55th for Case Commencement. At East 55th, head south to Euclid or Chester and then east to the Case campus.
