



TRAVEL ADVISORY FOR COMMENCEMENT DAY

Cornell Road Bridge Construction

The Cornell Road Bridge is being rebuilt and will be closed to vehicular traffic between Murray Hill and Circle Drive. There is a pedestrian bridge at the site, but vehicles must take alternate routes. For detailed directions to campus, go to: www.case.edu/visit/map/dir.html.

Directions for visitors from the east, who will be affected most by Cornell Bridge construction: From the east via Interstate 80 (Ohio Turnpike - From Eastern Ohio and Pennsylvania), take the Ohio Turnpike to the interchange for I-480 West (Exit 187). Proceed west on I-480, which merges with I-271 North. Stay north on I-271 then exit at Cedar Road (sharp right turn off exit ramp). Follow Cedar Road westbound toward Cleveland. (The university is about 20-25 minutes from this point.) Where Cedar starts down a steep hill, look for a sign identifying Case Western Reserve University on your right at the corner of Murray Hill Road. Turn right onto Murray Hill Road, left onto Adelbert Road and continue toward campus.

Cleveland Marathon

The Cleveland Rite Aid Marathon takes place on Commencement Day. The race route passes through University Circle on East Boulevard, close to the campus. Marathon participants are expected between 8:00 a.m. and 12 noon. This will affect both parking and traffic routes on the morning of commencement:

- Martin Luther King, Jr. (MLK) Boulevard will be totally closed to vehicular traffic between the VA hospital and the I-90/Route 2 Shoreway from 8:00 a.m. until about 1:00 p.m.
- East Boulevard will be totally closed to vehicular traffic between Ford Drive and the MLK traffic circle from 8:00 a.m. until about 1:00 p.m.
- East Boulevard between Euclid Avenue and Ford Drive will be restricted to one-way northbound traffic until 11:30 a.m.
- Chester Avenue will be restricted to eastbound traffic until 11:30 a.m.

If you are driving to campus from the east or west on I-90 the morning of Commencement, look for an electronic signboard (one for each direction) telling you to exit at East 55th for Case Commencement. At East 55th, head south to Chester and then east to the Case campus. East Boulevard can be accessed only from Euclid Avenue until the race is over, around 11:30 a.m. Anyone heading from Ford Drive or Bellflower Road will need to turn right at East Boulevard.
