UCI TO HOST HISTORIC MARKER DEDICATION CEREMONY FOR COZAD BATES HOUSE

Ohio Historic Marker commemorating The Cozad-Bates House. The house, built circa 1853, is the only pre-Civil War residential structure left in the University Circle neighborhood. It was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1974 and designated as a Cleveland Landmark in 2006.
