

Integrated BS/MS Program

Students who are candidates for the B.S. in engineering may apply to the Integrated B.S./M.S. Program. The program enables students to begin study towards the M.S. degree prior to completion of the B.S. degree, and allows 9 hours of credit to be counted towards both the B.S. and M.S. degrees. Students pursuing the program in chemical engineering generally take ECHE 460 Chemical Engineering Thermodynamics, ECHE 461 Transport Phenomena, and ECHE 651 Master Thesis as part of the Advanced Study Sequence. These courses will count both for the B.S. and M.S. degrees.

Students must apply for and be accepted into the B.S./M.S. program before completing the last two semesters of their B.S. degree. Students interested in the program should contact the department B.S./M.S. program advisor (Professor Edwards). The interested students should also contact Dean Hamel in the Undergraduate office to discuss intentions.

Students should complete a Graduate Studies application by downloading the form from www.case.edu/provost/gradstudies/programs.html and select “paper application.” Under no circumstances should a student fill out the on-line graduate application. This filled out form should be submitted to Professor Edwards.

Then, students should meet with Dean Hamel in Undergraduate Studies – Sears 3rd floor. The form “Combined Undergraduate/Graduate/Professional Programs” should be filled out and taken to the meeting with Dean Hamel. The form is attached to this document.

Three letters of recommendation must be obtained and submitted to Professor Edwards by the student.

If accepted, students must fill out and turn in to Professor Edwards a “Planned Program of Study” (PPOS) form. Professor Edwards will transfer the completed paperwork to Graduate Admissions.
