

Blackboard Learn

Blackboard Learn is the learning management software used by instructors to create course “sites” for their students where they can distribute class information, materials and assignments, as well as keep track of grades and communication with students. Blackboard Learn is used in many different ways. It is accessed by instructors, staff and students at blackboard.case.edu

Note: Blackboard is also the provider of point-of-sale software and fixtures that are used for the Case Card. Fixtures can be seen on the outside of vending machines. Blackboard Learn does not interact with point-of-sale functions.
