In case of a major campus emergency, Case Western Reserve University will utilize the CaseWARN text and voice messaging alert system, among other methods of communicating with faculty, staff and students. This emergency notification capability is an opt-in system. This system will be used only in the case of imminent danger or a serious threat to the campus community. Message delivery is not guaranteed.

To subscribe to the Case W.A.R.N. alert system, go to the [Emergency Notifications sign-up page](#). Enter your CWRU Network ID for the University's single sign on service, and you will automatically be directed to the Emergency Notification page. Choose whether you want to receive a text or voice message and fill in the appropriate phone number and wireless carrier if applicable. You must be a Case Western Reserve University faculty, staff or student to subscribe to the service.
