

## POST-DOCTORAL FELLOW POSITION

A post-doctoral fellow position will open on 3/1/2009 in Dr. Colleen Croniger's laboratory in the Department of Nutrition of Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine, Cleveland OH.

- The project integrates molecular biology, genetics and metabolism.
- The position requires proficiency in analysis of DNA by PCR, analyzing genetic mouse models for differences in diet response, performing real-time PCR, analysis of proteins by Western Blots as well as performing metabolic studies such as glucose tolerance tests.
- The position also requires good communication skills and interpersonal skills. The person will work with minimal radioactivity under the specified OCEA regulations and the regulations of the University.
