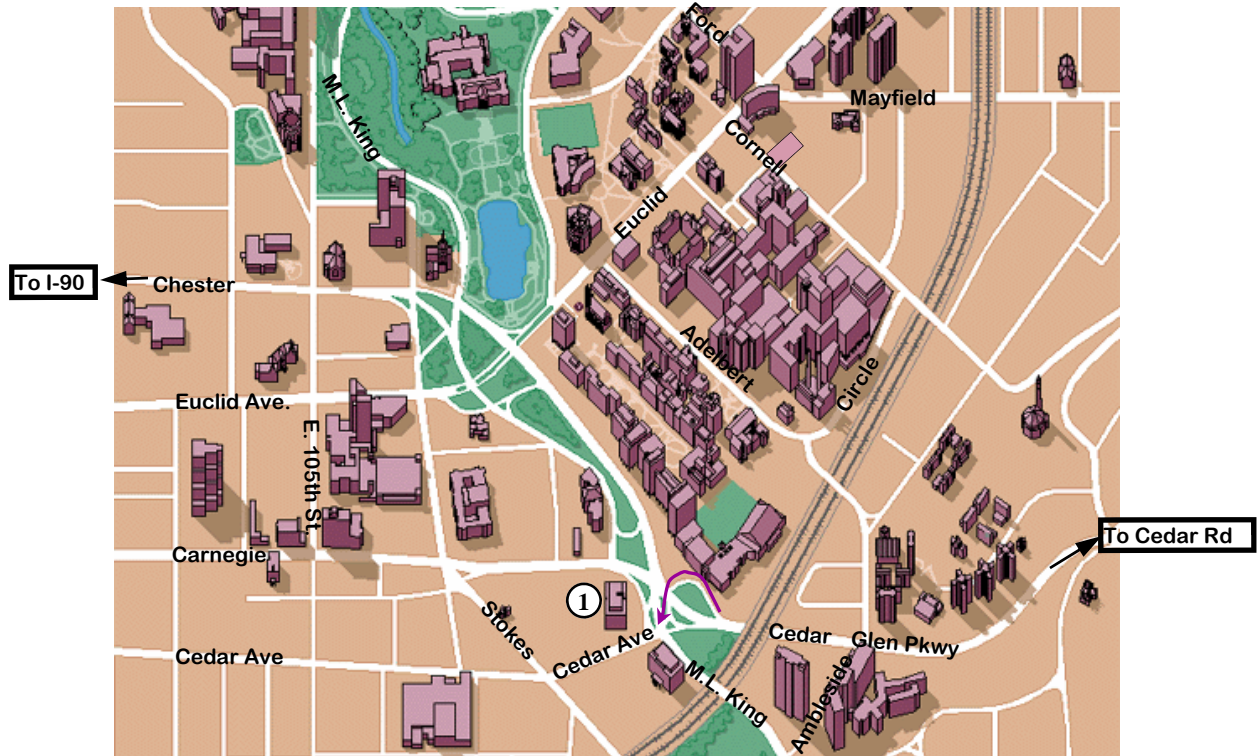


Map and Directions to Family Medicine, Research Division



1. Cuyahoga County Coroner's Office, aka UCRC II; Family Medicine Research Div., 3rd Floor, Ste. 306)

From the west via I-80 go east on the turnpike and exit at Interchange 142 (formerly 8A). Follow I-90 east.

At I-90 Exit 172C, turn RIGHT onto Ramp to Carnegie Ave. Continue east on Carnegie to E. 105th Street. Turn right and take E. 105th Street south to Cedar Avenue. Turn left and go east on Cedar Avenue. The next major intersection is Stokes Blvd. Cross Stokes, then start looking on your left for the sign, "Cuyahoga County Coroner's Office" (11001 Cedar Avenue) on your left.

[Note: There's a really complicated intersection just after the Coroner's office; if you go too far, continue on Cedar (keep the bus depot just to your right), go under the train overpass, then continue on Cedar Glen Parkway and take your first right, on Ambleside, and another right onto Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive (one-way). Go back down the hill and move into the left lane to get back to where you can turn left onto Cedar again].

Local by car: Come down Cedar Hill/Cedar Glen Pkwy and loop onto Cedar Avenue (see purple arrow), turn right into the parking lot.

From Case campus by University Circle bus: Take the "UCRC Loop" bus from the Rainbow main lobby. Our building is the next regular stop on the loop after that one. You can get the upcoming schedule here:

From Case on foot: Take the stairs just south of the Veale Gym and cut across the lot towards the Cedar/Carnegie intersection/ University rapid stop. Cross with care! You'll see twin tall buildings across the street. The Coroner's office is the one on the right.

Those coming by car should pull up and park by the sidewalk curb in front of the building and ask the guard at the front desk for a suggestion on where to park; sometimes it will be the garage, sometimes the spots out front.

Once in the building, sign in at the guard station, with Family Medicine as your destination. The guard may call Sara Torok (216-368-2756), or Willa Eisele (368-2758) for confirmation. From the elevators or front stairwell, go to the 3rd floor, walk toward the far end of the hall, then our suite (Suite 306) will be on the right, down a secondary corridor.
