Dr. Adele Viguera Lecture – Monday, May 19th, 2008

As part of the Center for Bipolar Disorder's continuing lecture series, **Adele Viguera, M.D.**, will present a lecture to the Psychiatry Department Staff on the topic of ***Predictors and Clinical Outcomes of Antidepressant Exposure among Pregnant Women with Bipolar Disorder.***

Dr. Viguera recently joined the Cleveland Clinic staff in 2007 and prior to that she had been the Associate Director of the Perinatal and Reproductive Psychiatry Clinical Research Program at Massachusetts General Hospital and Assistant Professor at Harvard Medical School.

During her years of study and practice she has been honored to be an invited reviewer for the *Journal of Immigrant and Minority Health*, *Menopause*, *Bipolar Disorders*, and the *Journal of Clinical Psychiatry*. She has also presented at Harvard Medical School, University of Pittsburgh Medical School, the Society for Women's Health Research, NYU School of Medicine, Rome, and at the Annual Meeting of the APA.
