

## Submission Guidelines

Discussions is an undergraduate research journal run by CWRU students. We accept research papers, review articles, and letters to the editor.

Submissions must be written by an undergraduate or team of undergraduates from any college or university. Each student/team must also have an advisor for the paper.

Please review the format and appearance of your paper before submitting.

Submit in the following format:

- Text: Times New Roman, 12 pt. font, double spaced
- Do not number pages.
  
- All references must be in MLA format (<http://www.mla.org>) or APA format (<http://owl.english.purdue.edu/owl/resource/560/01/>).
- Any graphs/images should be well-labeled and referenced in the text. Include images in the highest and clearest resolution possible.
- Submit TWO copies. Omit your name from the text of both:
  - 1) Cover Page must include title of paper, name, e-mail, mailing address, and advisor's name, department, and e-mail (or other contact information).
  - 2) Cover Page must include only title.
  - 3) BOTH) Send both as .doc documents. Title the documents as the title of the paper, with a 1 following the title for the first copy, and a 2 following the title for the second (i.e. Title1, Title2). Submit via email to [bethany.pope@case.edu](mailto:bethany.pope@case.edu).

- Also include the two following *short and concise* blurbs:

Acknowledgements written in the 1<sup>st</sup> person (i.e. I would like to thank...) to credit anyone who advised or assisted you in your research.

A brief bio of yourself written in the 3<sup>rd</sup> person (i.e. Sarah Smith is a second year student studying physics at CWRU. She is active in..., wishes to study..., etc.). Foreign Language Papers:

- Papers in a foreign language will be considered for publication, under the following stipulations:
  - 1) A brief English summary of the paper's contents must also be submitted.
  - 2) A signed endorsement by the paper's advisor (must be a professor of that language) must also be submitted, stating that the paper is fit for publication and that the summary accurately describes the paper.
