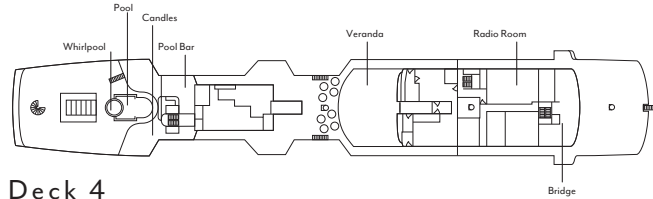

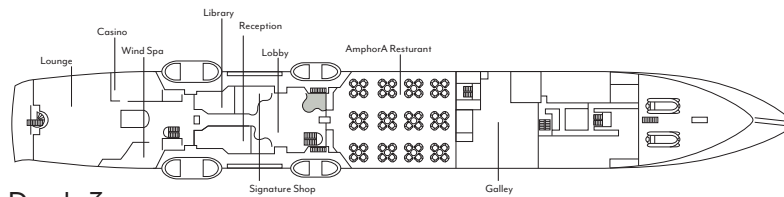

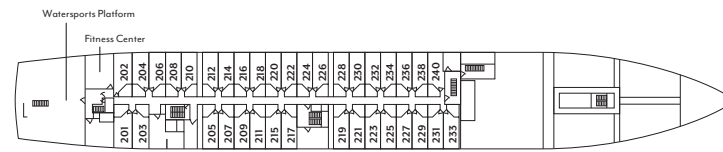
**One electrical outlet in each cabin can accommodate U.S.-style plugs with U.S. current of 110 volts/60 cycles. All other outlets will require an adapter.



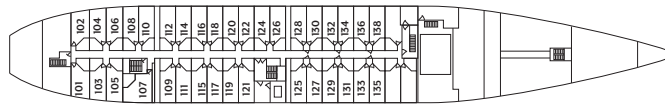

Currency

The Wind Star has a nonsmoking policy. Smoking is permitted on the outside decks in designated areas only.

Medical Services

Shipboard medical services and facilities, including doctor and medications, are available for a nominal charge. A first aid kit is available and officers are trained in basic first aid. Severe medical problems will require evacuation at the participant's expense.
